As the herald on a white horse in the 1913 Suffrage Parade in Washington, Inez Milholland symbolized the strength, power, and courage of women. Three years later, she became the martyr and inspiration for suffragists after dying while campaigning for Votes for Women. On January 19, we will gather in celebration of Inez and all advocates of human rights.

The local event begins with an outdoor march at Inez's grave in Lewis Cemetery behind the Lewis Congregational Church at 8557 US Route 9, where US-9 intersects with Fox Run Road/CR-10. The event then moves indoors to the Whallonsburg Grange for music, refreshments and more. From Lewis, head East on CR-10 (Lewis-Wadhams Road) about 7.5 miles to Wadhams. Turn left (East) onto Rt. 22. Drive 4 miles to 1610 NYS Route 22, Whallonsburg Grange.
